In the synagogue there was a man possessed by the spirit of an unclean demon, and he cried out with a loud voice, "Let us alone! What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!"

And amazement came upon them all, and they began talking with one another saying, "What is this message? For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits and they come out." And the report about Him was spreading into every locality in the surrounding district.

Demonology: The Basics

Demon = A created spiritual being that rebelled against God (II Peter 2:4; Jude 6).

What demons do: Act hostile to God, His works and His people. How? With lies (John 8:44) in order to blind people to the truth (II Corinthians 4:4). Satan is the prince of demons (Matthew 12:24).

Demonology: The Basics (cont.)

Demonic deception is subtle. Demons even pretend to be "religious" and have their own false doctrines (I Timothy 4:1-4). Demons may cause violent behavior (Luke 8:26-29); disease (Matthew 12:22), and may impress, influence and oppress Christians (Romans 12:2; Ephesians 2:1-7; II Chronicles 21:1; II Corinthians 12:7; Luke 4:1-13).
