THE REMOVAL OF THE LORDSHIP OF JESUS FROM THE SALVATION MESSAGE HAS AFFECTED THE AMERICAN CHURCH TO THE EXTENT THAT WE HAVE A CHURCH LOW ON MORALS AND DOCTRINAL STANDARDS AND AS IN EZEKIEL'S DAY THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS DEPARTED AND WE ARE LEFT PLAYING CHURCH BY OUR INVENTION OF THE DOCTRINE OF

> "EASY BELIEVERISM", "CHEAP GRACE", AND "NO LORDSHIP" MESSAGE AND LIFESTYLE

YOU CANNOT REMOVE THE LORDSHIP OF CHRIST FROM THE GOSPEL WITHOUT UNDERMINING FAITH AT ITS CORE JOHN MACARTHUR: THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JESUS

ON THE DAY OF PENTECOST PETER TOLD THOSE GATHERED

Acts 2:36 ESV

36 Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord [#2962] and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

Jesus called himself using thus term "KURIOS"

John 13:13 ESV

13 You call me Teacher and Lord [2962], and you are right, for so I am.

A WORD ABOUT WORDS

THE EXPRESSION MOST OFTEN
TRANSLATED "LORD" IN THE NT IS THE
GREEK WORD #2962 = KURIOS

It speaks of someone who has power, ownership, and an unquestionable right to command

NT:2962

<u>kurios (koo'-ree-os); from kuros (supremacy); supreme in authority, i.e.</u> (as noun) controller; by implication, Mr. (as a respectful title):

KJV - God, Lord, master, Sir.

A near synonymous tern is the Greek word "despotes" from which we get the English word "despot" = a ruler with absolute power over his subjects

Professor Murray J Harris distinguishes the two terms this way" clearly the words overlap in meaning; both may be rendered "lord" or "master" IF WE ARE TO

DISTINGUISH THE TWO TERMS WITH

REGARD TO EMPHASIS KYRIOS SIGNIFIES

"SOVEREIGN LORD" AND "DESPOTES"

"ABSOLUTE LORD"

Jude 4 ESV

4 For certain people have crept in unnoticed who long ago were designated for this condemnation, ungodly people, who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality and deny our only Master [1203] and Lord [2962], Jesus Christ.

NT:1203

despotes (des-pot'-ace); perhaps from NT:1210 and posis (a husband); an absolute ruler ("despot"):

KJV - Lord, master.

SLAVERY VOCABULARY

BOTH THESE WORDS ARE POWERFUL AND WERE PART OF THE VOCABULARY OF SLAVERY IN NT TIMES

WHENEVER THERE WAS A LORD [KURIOS]
AND A MASTER [DESPOTES] THERE WAS
ALWAYS A SLAVE [DOULOS]

TO THOSE WHO PAID HOMAGE TO JESUS WITH THEIR LIPS BUT NOT WITH THEIR LIVES HE ASKED

Luke 6:46 ESV

46 "Why do you call me 'Lord [2962], Lord [2962],' and not do what I tell you? THIS WORD "DOULOS" APPEARS IN FORM SOME 130 TIMES IN THE NT -FREQUENTLY AS A DESCRIPTION OF WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A TRUE CHRISTIAN

1 Cor 7:22-23 ESV

22 For he who was called in the Lord as a slave is a freedman of the Lord. Likewise he who was free when called is a slave [1401] of Christ. 23 You were bought with a price; do not become slaves of men.

NT:1401

doulos (doo'-los); from NT:1210; a slave (literal or figurative, involuntary or voluntary; frequently, therefore in a qualified sense of subjection or subserviency): KJV - bond (-man), servant.

DOULOS SUGGESTED A SPECIFIC CONCEPT, -WHILE REPUGNANT TO OUR CULTURE AND OUR NATURAL MINDS- SHOULD NOT BE TONED DOWN OR BACKED AWAY FROM IT IS THE MAIN GREEK WORD USED TO DESCRIBE THE LOWEST ABJECT BOND SLAVE A PERSON WHO WAS LITERALLY OWNED BY HIS MASTER, WHO COULD LEGALLY FORCE HIM TO WORK WITHOUT WAGES IN OTHER WORDS,

HE WAS A PERSON WITHOUT STANDING OR RIGHTS KITTELS DEFINITIVE DICTIONARY OF NEW TESTAMENT EXPRESSIONS STATES "....WE HAVE A SERVICE WHICH IS NOT A MATTER OF CHOICE FOR THE ONE WHO RENDERS IT, WHETHER HE LIKES IT OR NOT, BECAUSE HE IS SUBJECT AS A SLAVE TO AN ALIEN WILL, TO THE WILL OF HIS OWNER.

THE TERM STRESSES A SLAVE'S DEPENDENCE ON HIS LORD DOULOS SPEAKS OF SLAVERY PURE AND SIMPLE EDWIN YAMAUCHI SHOWS BY THE END OF THE 13TH CENTURY "SLAVERY DISAPPEARED FROM NORTWESTERN **EUROPE.... AND WAS KNOWN TO THE** 17TH CENTURY ENGLISHMEN... AS A REMOTE PHENOMENON.... THE CONCEPT OF WHAT IT MEANT TO BE A SERVANT

WAS SHAPED BY THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF SERFDOM – A TYPE OF SERVITUDE WHERE THE LABOURER WAS BOUND TO THE LAND WHERE HE WORKED

THIS SLAVERY IS A MESSAGE THAT IS OFFENSIVE TO HUMAN WISDOM

[1 CORINTHIANS 1-22-31;

2 CORINTHIANS 4:5]

THE IDEA THAT JESUS DEMANDED ABSOLUTE SLAVE-LIKE OBEDIENCE TO HIS LORDSHIP IS A PARTICULARLY DIFFICULTY FOR PEOPLE FROM CONTEMPORARY WESTERN CULTURES TO GRASP TO BE A DISCIPLE OF JESUS MEANT THAT YOUR WHOLE LIFE WAS PLACED UNDER HIS AUTHORITY HIS LORDSHIP WAS TOTAL AND NON-NEGOTIABLE

THOSE WERE HIS TERMS AND WOULD BE DISCIPLES WHO TRIED TO DICTATE DIFFERENT TERMS WERE ALWAYS TURNED AWAY [LUKE 9:59-62]

WE ARE NOT CALLED TO PERSONAL CLICHES

WE ARE NOT CALLED TO "A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS"

YOU CANNOT HAVE HIM AS SAVIOR NOW TO DECIDE LATER IF YOU WANT HIM AS LORD [THE NO LORDSHIP MESSAGE]

AMONG THE ORIGINAL 12 ONLY ONE –
JUDAS ---WANTED JESUS AS "FRIEND"
WITHOUT EVER REALLY BOWING TO HIS
AUTHORITY AS LORD AND MASTER

Matt 7:21-23 ESV

21 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. 22 On that day many will say to me, 'Lord [2962], Lord [2962], did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?'

23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'
