1 I have a message from God in my heart concerning the sinfulness of the wicked: There is no fear of God before their eyes.

2 In their own eyes they flatter themselves too much to detect or hate their sin.

3 The words of their mouths are wicked and deceitful; they fail to act wisely or do good. 4 Even on their beds they plot evil; they commit themselves to a sinful course and do not reject what is wrong.

SERMON : THE BLESSINGS OF GOD

Luke 6:37-42 NIV

37 “Do not [a]judge, and you will not be judged; and do not [b]condemn, and you will not be condemned; [c]pardon, and you will be pardoned. 38 Give, and it will be given to you. They will [d]pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return.”

**39 Now He also spoke a parable to them:
“A person who is blind cannot guide
another who is blind, can he? Will they
not both fall into a pit? 40 A [e]student is
not above the teacher; but everyone,
when he has been fully trained, will be
like his teacher. 41 Why do you look at the
[f]speck that is in your brother’s eye, but
do not notice the log that is in your own
eye?”**

42 How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me take out the [g]speck that is in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the log that is in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take out the [h]speck that is in your brother's eye.
