MORNING READING

Psalm 107:1-13 KJV

1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy; **3** And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south.

4 They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way;

they found no city to dwell in. **5** Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. **6** Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses. **7** And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation. **8** Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! **9** For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness.
