“Jesus Heals Ten Men With Leprosy”

11 Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee.

12 As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy[b] met him. They stood at a distance

13 and called out in a loud voice, “Jesus, Master, have pity on us!”

14 When he saw them, he said, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed.

1 Jesus said to his disciples: “Things that cause people to stumble are bound to come, but woe to anyone through whom they come.

2 It would be better for them to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around their neck than to cause one of these little ones to stumble.

3 So watch yourselves.

“If your brother or sister[a] sins against you, rebuke them; and if they repent, forgive them..

4 Even if they sin against you seven times in a day and seven times come back to you saying ‘I repent,’ you must forgive them.” **5** The apostles said to the Lord, “Increase our faith!” **6** He replied, “If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be uprooted and planted in the sea,’ and it will obey you. **7** “Suppose one of you has a servant plowing or looking after the sheep. Will he say to the servant when he comes in from the field, ‘Come along now and sit down to eat’?

8 Won't he rather say, 'Prepare my supper, get yourself ready and wait on me while I eat and drink; after that you may eat and drink'? **9** Will he thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? **10** So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.'"
